1. People change their environment
Adaptation: change to fit the situation

Interaction

2. People change their environment
Modification: changing the situation to fit your needs

3. People depend on their environment for needs

Dependence: need to live

*It is not always clear which is which. Sometimes humans interact with their environment for more than one reason
